Take notice that the duly elected Council of the City of Uniontown intends to adopt the following proposed ordinances at a Special Meeting of City Council on December 15, 2022:

1. Bill No. 1762, Proposed Ordinance No. 1742,

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF UNIONTOWN, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
SHOWING THE ESTIMATED RECEIPTS, EXPENDITURES, AND LIABILITIES OF
EVERY KIND OF ALL THE FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 WITH THE BALANCE OF
UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS AS THE BASIS FOR FIXING THE LEVY AND TAX
RATE FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING
EXPENDITURES OF THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS SHOWN AS PROPOSED
EXPENDITURES HEREIN FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE CITY FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR
FROM THE REVENUE AVAILABLE FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE DEPARTMENTS,
BUREAUS, AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN, AND THE REPEALING OF
ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; (THE
BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL 2023)

2. Bill No. 1763, Proposed Ordinance No. 1743,

AN ORDINANCE

FIXING THE SALARIES PAYABLE BY THE CITY OF UNIONTOWN FOR THE
VARIOUS POSITIONS ENUMERATED HEREIN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023, AND
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT
HEREWITH;

3. Bill No. 1764, Proposed Ordinance No. 1744,

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF UNIONTOWN, COUNTY OF FAYETTE, AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR ALL CITY PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.
