Review and Accept Previous Meeting Minutes

Board voted unanimously to approve minutes from the previous meeting on 1-18-2026.

New Business

Board voted unanimously to appoint Wyatt Olson to the Chair position for the Board. Kelly Trott will continue to serve as Secretary.

Board unanimously to make an exception for the Uniontown Public Library to participate as a vendor for the 2026 Farmers Market due to the library being an entity of the City of Uniontown. Board agreed to waive fees for the library.

Board voted unanimously to approve fitness events to be held before the farmers markets begin at Bailey Park or promote events held in the South Union Sports Complex. Events will be organized by the Uniontown YMCA in collaboration with other local fitness instructors/organizations. The board agreed that if fitness classes are held at Bailey Park, classes should be offered free to the public. If instructors/organizations offer donation based classes, a \$20 fee will be required.

A vote was not required to request garbage bags as Councilwoman Brown informed the board garbage bags will be provided.

The board discussed:

-discontinuing participation in the NexTrex program as the program has changed. A second bench has been received and two benches are available for placement.

-concern for broken equipment on Bailey Park's playground.

-revitalizing shuffle board and horseshoe pits at Bailey Park.

-taking sight visits to each park to outline goals.

-possible community events such as community play nights, movie events, etc.

-possible improvements to the farmers market including a storage shed and sponsorships.

-requiring farmers market vendors to be 18 while youth participation may continue to be explored.
